Bowls England Clarification

We received some questions regarding the Bowls England COVID-19: SUPPLEMENTARY GUIDANCE FOR LAWN BOWLS CLUBS issued yesterday. We sought clarification and received the following additional advice:

Further to the guidance issued on Tuesday 2nd June, Bowls England wishes to confirm that it is for each club to determine what formats it can safely allow/accommodate within the Government guidance - singles/pairs/triples - and the maximum number of people permitted on club grounds at any one time. Clubs should consider the provision of a marker for singles play and attendance (or otherwise) of 'spectators' as part of these deliberations, and include them within their maximum number. The Government guidance on participation by those classed as critically vulnerable (which includes those aged over 70) remains unchanged and is detailed within our FAQ issued on Tuesday 2nd June.
